Currently, only employees of the PrestaShop company can be maintainer, with the code review and code merge power.







### How to become a committer

In the PrestaShop project, committers are contributors with merge rights.

Committers participate in reviewing code contributions.

#### Prerequisites to become a committer

1. Active participation in the project

- Have at least one accepted, guality Pull Request.
- Display a record of Pull Request reviews.
- Real interest in getting involved in code review.

#### 2. Cultural convergence

- Respect the Code of Conduct; behave respectfully and in good faith.
- Agree to work together with the rest of the maintainer team towards main goals (see The Future Architecture): migration to Symfony, adoption of VueJS ...

#### Requirements to continue being a committer

All the above, plus:

1. Continuous participation and involvement

- Actively and responsibly review Pull Requests.
- 2. Responsible behavior




