

- Digital is not politically neutral
- Tech giants have made digital a political object (Cambridge Analytica, Russian influence on elections, etc.)
- There are many ways to deal with digital
- \rightarrow Awareness of political issues related to digital technology

- Many free software deployment projects in public service have failed
- \rightarrow A strategy is needed

3. RAISING AWARENESS

• Free software isn't the objective, it's a means

→ THE GOAL IS TO HAVE THE BEST PUBLIC SERVICE

- Do not assert, demonstrate
 - → IDENTIFY VOLUNTEERS
- Take the time to do things right
 - → NO TARGET DATE
 - \rightarrow No target numbers

4. Contributing

- Free software as in *free beer*
 - \rightarrow Yes, free software saves you money
 - \rightarrow Yes, free software gives you greater autonomy

Financial contribution

- → PAY FOR SOFTWARE SETUP SERVICES
- → PURCHASE SUPPORT CONTRACTS
- Technical contribution
 - \rightarrow 20% FTE of a developer

5. Communicating

- Let people know that a transition to free software is possible
 - \rightarrow Use your own communication channels
 - \rightarrow Don't tell, show
 - \rightarrow Share tools and tips with other local authorities
- Communicate on other ecosystem players' projects
 - \rightarrow Monitor technology and share best practices

6. Federating

• Technical federation

→ Federate tools (Mastodon, Peertube, Nextcloud, etc.)

• Geographic federation

- → LOCAL (ALPES NUMERIQUE LIBRE), NATIONAL (ADULLACT, APRIL, OW2...), INTERNATIONAL (OPENFORUM, EUROPEAN COMMISSION)
- Organizational federation
 - → HOW CAN WE BUILD BRIDGES BETWEEN DIFFERENT COMMUNITIES OF INTEREST?
